- 3 YEARS+
- 1-3 YEARS
- 0-1 YEAR

**NUMBER OF CHILDREN**

- How many families are we aiming to house based on our resource capacity?

5 -10 Families Matched to Housing

Need 30-45 completed Family  
VISPDAT's before **December 10<sup>TH</sup>**

## PILOT

30 Families Matched to Housing  
Resource

Need 100 Family VISPDAT's  
completed between **November  
and February28th**



# PRIORITIZATION - NEXT STEPS:

OCTOBER: (TEST)

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NOV/DEC: (TEST/ASSESS, REVIEW, REVISE)

- ~~◦ CoC funded resources only?~~
- ~~◦ Open up to ALL resources?~~

~~Determine what resources and/or source of surveys we can test~~

Test and meet as the workgroup attempts to prioritize

Meet weekly to review process

- Did it require subjective calls or did the process work for us?
- How did prioritization check against “gut feeling”
- How did prioritization match?

Make recommendations on the next 100days
