February 24, 2017

- Nine leased up; six in queue (two have vouchers and one has complete packet; one individual leasing up next Wednesday)
- Process: smooth; good communication
- Services: getting to know landlords better and develop rapport
- Concerns: one youth (with partner and 2 children) with a number of issues, including with landlord. May have to move from current location.
- Case conference: If want case conference with youth due to significant issues, a meeting will be arranged with the youth and their support system. Lauren will initiate and set up meeting with key people (referring agency, VOA case manager, other supports)
- Do we do case conferences for all youth pre-move-in for warm hand-off, open communication
- Agency page: some still in progress. UPD, VOA, Family Tree and AH are currently set up. A number of ROI's are missing which is slowing the process.
- Prioritization
 - Do we need a different way to prioritize?
 - Current: score, co-morbidity, age, time homeless, DV and sexual exploitation
 - Score measure results in a mix of ages
 - Lengths of time homeless = same as above
 - Potential priorities:
 - Length of time homeless
 - Score
 - Co-occurring
 - Youngest
 - In the case of the above, seeing a variety of ages, focus remains in higher scores, but some lower scores being picked up due to length of time homeless (system updates length of time homeless automatically)
 - Consider all scores needing PSH as equal 8+
 - Length of time homeless
 - Co-occurring
 - Age
 - Results the youngest rising to top
 - Scores: nine -24's, five 23's, five 22's, five 21's, eleven 20's, six 19's, one 18
 - Where sleep most frequently: again, end up with youngest to oldest
 - Some communities focused on unsheltered youth
- Alternative process continues to be discussed

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- Renee will send out the de-identified info to agencies
- Bridge housing thoughts: possibly use some of the funding for bridge housing at CCH
- New website will be up and running by next meeting (Ian promises)
