Urban Peak Drop-In Center:

- opens at 8 am
- no eligibility requirements, except age (24 years old and younger)
- they offer classes Monday, Wednesday, Friday, with a hot lunch afterwards as incentive
- Monday classes are about mindfulness and Friday classes are reserved for board games with the staff in order to build community
- a semi-consistent group of youth have been attending classes regularly
